

BARRICADE

Construct a barricade to safeguard personnel when the following conditions exist:

1. When overhead work creates a hazard.
2. When tripping hazards are created.
3. When excavations are made.
4. When a condition exists that causes a harmful substance to drain, spill, spray, or leak.
5. When driving hazards are created.
6. When spray painting is being done.
7. When working around pipes and other equipment.
8. When working around or cleaning tanks or vessels.

General Requirements

1. Barricades shall be visible.
2. A barricade shall be placed far enough away from the work area to prevent a hazard.
3. Barricades may consist of safety tape, pendant type flagging, sawhorses, or fencing.
4. Tape or pendant type barricades can be no higher than five feet or lower than two feet from the surface.
5. Barricades at night, around the hazard or excavation, shall be illuminated.
6. No one removes a barricade without authorization.
